The **Kerman Enrichment Summer Adventures Senior** program is a **FREE** summer enrichment opportunity for Kerman Unified youth to participate in. Youth will be involved in activities promoting literacy, nutrition, fitness, STEM, and social emotional learning.

-KESA 2021 COVID changes

KESA 2021 will operate differently this year. Each elementary school campus in Kerman USD will host 100-125 of their own students on site. This will allow the program to serve the students of Kerman while following COVID procedures to ensure the safety of students and staff.

Students will receive instruction from a Kerman USD credentialed teacher in the morning and will then have enrichment classes with California Teaching Fellow staff in the afternoon.
